AREA VIDEOGRAPHY



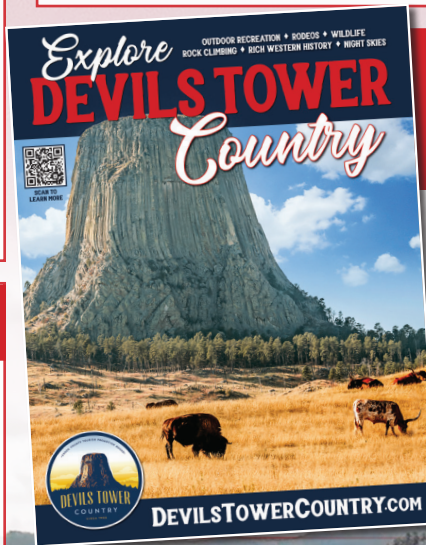

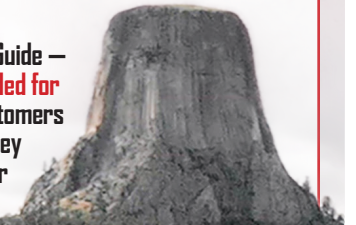

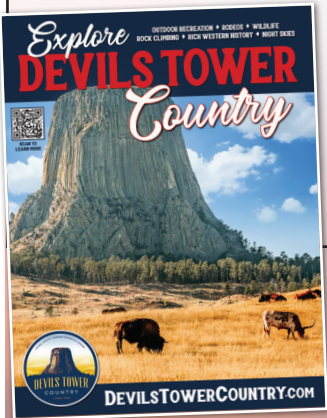
2 CLAIM & MAINTAIN YOUR GOOGLE BUSINESS LISTING
